

# Valinor Farm Eventing Clinic Required Equipment

Riders must wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet at all times when mounted. Riders must wear breeches and boots, or jodphur boots and leggings when riding. No riding will be allowed without proper dress. For safety reasons, no cotton or nylon sneakers or other casual shoes will be permitted while working in the barn areas. All items on the following list are important and required for participants' safety and their horses' well-being. Please make sure that all tack items are properly fitted and in good working order. Please check the condition of all stitching and leather, and make sure that all equipment is clearly marked with your name.

## **EQUIPMENT FOR THE RIDER**

- Riding Helmet – ASTM/SEI approved
- Protective vest for crosscountry
- Breeches or jodhpurs
- Riding boots or jodhpur boots
- Belt
- Raincoat
- Watch

## **EQUIPMENT FOR THE HORSE**

**\*\*\* All feed, supplements, etc. should be pre-packaged and labeled by day for the duration of the clinic.**

- Regular bridle and bit
- Running martingale (if needed)
- Saddle, stirrups, leathers
- 2-4 saddle pads
- 2 girths
- Spurs (if needed)
- Dressage whip and crop/bat
- Fly spray and wipe
- Hoof pick
- Dandy brush, body brush, and rubber curry comb
- Sweat scraper
- Towels or rags
- Large and small sponges
- Mane comb/pulling comb
- Shampoo
- Sheet
- Cooler
- Bandages, cotton or leg quilts
- Two cotton lead ropes
- Two halters – LEATHER (or nylon with breakaway headpiece)
- Masking tape
- Shipping boots and/or wraps
- Galloping boots and wraps

## **EQUIPMENT FOR THE TACK AREA**

- Tack trunk
- Saddle rack
- 5 pails: 2 5-gallon for water, 1 large feed, 1 for bathing, 1 plastic for tack cleaning
- Shovel, rake & manure fork
- Salt block
- Yarn or thread/rubberbands for braiding
- Tack cleaning kit: saddle soap, Tack Sponges, metal polish, etc.
